SUMMARY: Sixty-two percent of voters approved Initiative 148 on November 2,

2004. The law took effect that same day. It removes state-level criminal penalties on the use, possession and cultivation of marijuana by patients who possess written documentation from their physicians authorizing the medical use of marijuana. Patients diagnosed with the following illnesses are afforded legal protection under this act: cachexia or wasting syndrome; severe or chronic pain; severe nausea; seizures, including but not limited to seizures caused by epilepsy; or severe or persistent muscle spasms, including but not limited to spasms caused by multiple sclerosis or Crohn's disease. Patients (or their primary caregivers) may possess no more than six marijuana plants. The law

Possession/Cultivation: A qualifying patient and a qualifying patient's caregiver may each possess six marijuana plants and one ounce of usable marijuana.

establishes a confidential state-run patient registry that issues identification cards

"Usable marijuana" means the dried leaves and flowers of marijuana and any mixture or preparation of marijuana.

Legal and medical status of cannabis - Wikipedia, the free encyclopedia | Cannabis is in Schedule IV of the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, making it subject to special restrictions. Article 2 provides for the following, in reference to Schedule IV drugs:

A Party shall, if in its opinion the prevailing conditions in its country render it the most appropriate means of protecting the public health and welfare, prohibit the production, manufacture, export and import of, trade in, possession or use of any such drug except for amounts which may be necessary for medical and scientific research only, including clinical trials therewith to be conducted under or subject to the direct supervision and control of the Party.

This provision, while apparently providing for the limitation of cannabis to research purposes only, also seems to allow some latitude for nations to make their own judgments. The official Commentary on the Single Convention indicates that Parties are expected to make that judgment in good faith. Click > here < for more.

Montana medical marijuana patient Scott Day dies; wife still faces prosecution - Last update: December 16, 2008 | On September 9, Scott Day unexpectedly passed away. Scott suffered from a terminal degenerative disease called muccopolysaccharidosis. He used medical marijuana to get relief from his constant pain and muscle spasms. Our thoughts and condolences are with Scott's family.

Earlier this year, Scott and his wife Summer were raided, arrested, and charged with manufacturing marijuana. Despite the fact that Scott was clearly growing and using marijuana to treat the symptoms of his terminal illness, the county moved forward with their prosecution. In November, two months after Scott's death, District Judge Loren Tucker ruled against a motion to dismiss the case. Despite Scott's death, Jed Fitch, Beaverhead county attorney, still plans to prosecute Summer. Her case is scheduled to go to trial in February.
